#### Part 7 - Faith vs. Unbelief

#### Text: Hebrews 11:1 God's Word Translation

"Faith assures us of things we expect and convinces us of the existence of things we cannot see." Faith is being confident of what we expect, convinced of what we don't see.

### THE NEGATIVE IMPACT

- The result of unbelief (Numbers 14:1-4 NKJV)
  - 1. The people wept and cried
  - 2. The people complained against Moses and Aaron
  - 3. The people blamed God for their situation
  - 4. The people spoke of returning back to slavery (Romans 8:6 NKJV)

## WHAT FAITH SOUNDS LIKE (Numbers 14:6-9 NKJV)

- Caleb and Joshua mirrored what God had said
  - 1. This is a good land just as God has said
  - 2. The Lord will bring us in and give the land to us
  - 3. Don't rebel against the Lord by disobeying what He said (Hebrews 11:8 NKJV)
  - 4. Don't fear the people because the Lord is with us (Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJV)
- · Most everything Caleb and Joshua said was invisible
  - 1. Based on what God had said to the people
  - The invisible things God will give us this land
  - 3. So what things are you believing right now that are invisible?

# HOW DID JOSHUA AND CALEB GET TO A BETTER PLACE? (Joshua 14:7-8 NKJV)

- It's a heart thing
  - 1. Brought back word as it was in my heart
  - The ten spies made the heart of the people melt
  - 3. Caleb said he wholly followed God
  - 4. God said that Caleb was different (Numbers 14:22-24 NKJV)
  - 5. Caleb wound up taking a mountain (Joshua 14:12-13 NKJV)
