BECAUSE WE HAVE A GOD

A KING'S BIG MISTAKE (2 Kings 1:1-4 CSB)

- · God was not a part of Ahaziah's life
 - 1. His father and mother were horrible influences
 - 2. Ahaziah worshipped Baal so he looked to Baal for answers
- · But Azahiah was king over God's people
 - 1. The God of Israel was to have been his God
 - 2. God had people who still served Him
 - 3. And God had revealed Himself as God to Ahab and Jezebel
 - 4. Ahaziah had opportunity to turn to the real God

WE HAVE A GOD

- And our God is for us (Romans 8:31-32 NKJ)
 - 1. We have something to say about things
 - 2. My God did not spare His Son for me
- Our God is our Father (Romans 8:15-16 NKJ)
 - 1. He has never intended we live in fear
 - 2. We have been adopted into God's family

BECAUSE WE HAVE A GOD

- · Acting like we have a God
 - 1. In the Old Testament, God's people would meet at the temple
 - 2. Also, God's people would build altars/memorials
 - 3. We have a place to meet church
 - 4. We can also build altars/memorials in our life
- Ways we build a personal memorial, acting like we have a God (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 NKJ)
 - 1. All of these involve our words
 - 2. All of these require a different mindset (Romans 12:2 NKJ)
- Rejoice always
 - 1. Rejoice to be glad, joyful
 - 2. Rejoice when something good happens (Acts 11:21-23 CSB)
 - 4. Rejoice with others (Romans 12:15 NKJ)
 - 5. Rejoice in the Lord (Philippians 3:1 NKJ) (Philippians 4:4 NKJ)
