THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS SPOKEN ABOUT BY THE OLD TESTATMENT PROPHETS

- Isaiah described His characteristics (Isaiah 11:2 NKJ)
 - 1. Those attributes have not changed
- Ezekiel spoke of a coming day, which is the time we are now living (Ezekiel 36:26-27 NKJ)
 - 1. The heart of flesh is the new creation
 - 2. The Spirit within takes place at the New Birth (1 Corinthians 6:19 NKJ)
- Joel spoke of the coming day and the Holy Spirit's outpouring (Joel 2:28-29 NKJ)
 - 1. The passage Peter spoke of on the day of Pentecost
 - 2. A distinction is made here of the Holy Spirit within and the Holy Spirit upon

THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE LIFE OF JESUS

- Pre and post birth
 - 1. The Holy Spirit at conception (Luke 1:34-35 NKJ)
 - 2. The Holy Spirit encouraged Mary during her pregnancy (Luke 1:39-43 NKJ)
 - 3. The Holy Spirit confirmed Jesus at His dedication (Luke 2:25-30 NKJ)
- · The early ministry of Jesus
 - 1. John the Baptist spoke of Jesus and the Holy Spirit (Luke 3:16 NKJ)
 - 2. We see the Holy Spirit on Jesus at the start of His ministry (Luke 3:21-22 NKJ)
 - 3. Jesus referenced the Holy Spirit's equipping Him to help people (Luke 4:18 NKJ) (Acts 10:38 NKJ)

THE HOLY SPIRIT HELPS THE EARLY CHURCH

- He was instrumental in reaching out to the Gentiles (Acts 10:19-20 NKJ)
 - 1. The Jewish believers did not consider Gentiles within the sphere of salvation
 - 2. It required a vision and direct command from the Holy Spirit to open that door
- He helped guide the early church into a major decision regarding the nations (Acts 15:28 NKJ)
 - 1. The early church used the scriptures and the direct involvement of the Holy Spirit
