- · We choose who comes in
 - 1. If you are sketchy no go
 - 2. If you can help
 - 3. If you are close family / friend
- · Home is a metaphor for our personal life
 - 1. Inviting Jesus to be a part of your personal life (Revelations 3:20 NLT)
 - 2. The purpose is fellowship a sharing together
 - 3. There is so much He can add totally worth your time

A MAN WHO LET JESUS IN (Luke 19:1-9 NLT)

- · Zacchaeus; A man of many layers
 - 1. He had what most people want power and wealth
 - 2. He also had what most people have a level of hurt
 - 3. But he also had a spiritual hunger ran, climbed a tree to see Jesus
- Zacchaeus; A man no one expected Jesus to notice
 - 1. Certainly not to spend time with a notorious sinner
 - 2. Jesus invited Himself to Zac's house
- Zacchaeus's interaction with Jesus changed him
 - 1. For the first time, Zac was accepted by God
 - 2. He discovered a purpose bigger than money and power
 - 3. Zac took steps of change

WHEN YOU INVITE JESUS IN

- His open invitation to you (1 Corinthians 1:9 CSB)
 - 1. To call someone in order that they may come or go somewhere
 - 2. How do you fellowship with the Lord?
- He will share His perspective of you
 - 1. Your image is made up of background, experience, wins and losses, what others have said
 - 2. Jesus sees you with different eyes, a spiritual perspective (1 Peter 2:9 NLT)
- · He will add value to your life, not hurt
 - 1. What Jesus added to Zacchaeus empowered him to live differently
 - 2. He adds the power to live differently (Ephesians 2:10 NLT)
 - 3. He adds a purpose bigger than you
