Text: (Hebrews 11:1 God's Word Translation)

PAUL KNEW FAITH WAS IMPORTANT (1 Thessalonians 3:1-10 NKJV)

- Paul had founded the Thessalonian church
 - 1. These believers had turned to God from idols
 - 2. They had experienced difficult times from the onset of their new faith
 - 3. Paul had a great affection for this church parental
- Paul was concerned about their faith (1 Thessalonians 3:1-3 CSB)
 - 1. There was a purpose to Timothy's visit
 - 2. In order that the believers would not be shaken
 - 3. Stronger faith could not keep all troubles from coming
 - 4. Faith is not fixed but has to be fed and developed (Romans 10:17 NKJV)
 - a. Feed your faith
 - → by listening to messages
 - ⇒ by reading scriptures
 - by speaking and meditating on scriptures
- Paul's relief (1 Thessalonians 3:5-8 CSB)
 - 1. Timothy was sent to also find out about their faith
 - 2. Faith is observed in words and actions
 - a. The actions of the five men (Mark 2:3-5 NKJV)
 - b. The centurion's words (Matthew 8:5-10 NKJV)
 - 3. There was good news about their faith and love
 - 4. Paul was encouraged by the faith of the church
 - 5. By faith they stood firm in the Lord
